This does **not** include lunch on the first day, Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March (the first item on the programme is at 2.15 p.m.) but it **does** include lunch on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March. The total cost is £310. This includes a non-refundable deposit of £60. A complimentary copy of the talks given at the Pilgrimage, published subsequently, will also be sent to participants.

*The Shrine authorities' timetable for bookings is early and so we I should be grateful to have your deposit to reserve your place as soon as possible!*

The balance of £250 should be paid by 19<sup>th</sup> February 2024. As in previous years, if you would like to send, as applicable, a post-dated cheque (19<sup>th</sup> February) for the balance, that would help our arrangements.

*Please note that we ask all pilgrims to pay £60, whether or not they are staying at the Anglican Shrine. If you are planning to stay elsewhere overnight and you wish to join us for meals at the Anglican Shrine, please let us know nearer the time and we will make the necessary arrangements.*
