The 2025 Ecumenical Pilgrimage to Walsingham will take place from Tuesday 11th to Friday 14th March. Accommodation (full board and accessible) is at the Anglican Shrine. The full cost is £345, or £60 for non-residents.

The programme will include:

- **Sung Mass** at the Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham and Catholic National Shrine
- **Sung Eucharist** in the Anglican Shrine Church
- **Divine Liturgy** of the Orthodox Church
- **Methodist Holy Communion Service**
- **Akathist Hymn** before the Icon of the Theotokos from the Chapel of the Life-Giving Spring of the Mother of God, in the Anglican Shrine Church
- **Visits to the Holy House and Sprinkling at the Well**
- **Daily Catholic Mass, Anglican Eucharist and Bible Studies**
- **A Church music presentation**

A booking form is attached - please return by 30th January 2026. Transfer by coach from Kings Lynn to Walsingham and back is available for those travelling by train at an extra cost of £40 p.p. return. Please indicate on the booking form whether you would like to use the coach.

Full board accommodation is at the Anglican Shrine. This does **not** include lunch on the first day, Tuesday 10th March (the first item on the programme is at 2.15 p.m.) but it **does** include lunch on Friday 13th March. The total cost is £345. This includes a non-refundable deposit of £60. A complimentary copy of the talks given at the Pilgrimage, published subsequently, will also be sent to participants.

The Shrine authorities' timetable for bookings is early and so we should be grateful to have your deposit to reserve your place as soon as possible!

The balance of £285 should be paid and reach us by 20th February 2026. As in previous years, if you would like to send, as applicable, a post-dated cheque (20th February) for the balance, that would help our arrangements.

Please note that we ask all pilgrims to pay £60, whether or not they are staying at the Anglican Shrine. If you are planning to stay elsewhere overnight and you wish to join us for meals at the Anglican Shrine, there will be an additional charge. Please let us know and we will make the necessary arrangements.
